- 9. How high is this position? (V. 21) (see Col. 1:16)
- 10. Where has God placed "all things"? What does this mean? (V. 22) (see Mt 28:18)
- 11. Who is Christ to the church? (V. 22). (See Col 1:18)
- 12. Who is the church in relation to Christ? (V. 23)
