Seated with Him

- 1. What new state did Christ put us in (i.e. believers)? What was our former state? (V. 1)
- In the past, how did we 'walk' (=live)? Who was defining our lives? Why?
- 3. What was our life like before we accepted Christ? (V3)
- 4. What did God do for us? (V 4, 5) And why? What is it to you to be "made alive together with Christ"?
- 5. If believers are "made alive together with Christ" what is our current position? How can this be? (V 6)
- 6. By what are we saved? (V8) Through what? What is the source of our faith? (V8)
- 7. Can we be "saved by our works? (V9) Why is this?
- 8. What was God's purpose in "saving" us (e.g. bringing us into His Kingdom)? (V 7)
- 9. What does it mean that "we are God's workmanship? (V10) What is God calling us to do?

Glossary of terms:

Grace = God's unmerited favour.

Salvation = Wholeness

Greek: 'sozo' to make whole, heal, be well, preserve, protect, save.

Greek word translated "Walked" (parpateo) – means to walk

- 1. to make one's way, progress; to make due use of opportunities
 - 2. Hebrew for, to live
 - 1. to regulate one's life
 - 2. to conduct one's self
 - 3. to pass one's life

Strong's Definition: to tread all around, i.e. walk at large; figuratively, to live, deport oneself, follow (as a companion or votary):—go, be occupied with, walk (about).
