Calling Greek: "klases"

- 1.a calling, calling to
 - 2. a call, invitation
 - 1. to a feast
 - 2. of the divine invitation to embrace salvation of God

Called Greek "kaleo"

- 1. to call
 - 1. to call aloud, utter in a loud voice
 - 2. to invite
- 2. to call i.e. to name, by name
 - 1. to give a name to
 - 1. to receive the name of, receive as a name
 - 2. to give some name to one, call his name
 - 2. to be called i.e. to bear a name or title (among people)
 - 3. to salute one by name

Used in:

<u>Verse 1</u>: "urge you to live a life worthy of the **calling** you have received" (NKJV) or "the **vocation** to which you have been **called**." (NIV)

<u>Verse 4</u>: "even as you are **called** in one hope of your **calling**." (NKJV) Or "Just as you were **called** to one hope when you were **called**." (NIV) (Also used in Ephesians 1:18)
